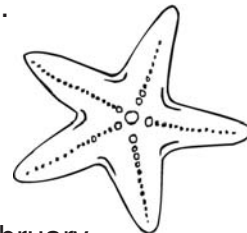
STAMPING CHALLENGE

Winners will be announced February 16. No pressure, just fun. Join the challenge!

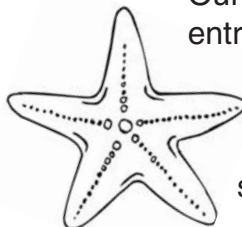


BEADING CHALLENGE
